Dr. Ritwik is Professor of Pediatric Dentistry at the University of Texas Houston School of Dentistry. She is a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry, Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry and Fellow of the American College of Dentists.



Dr. Ritwik received her degree in dental surgery in India. She then worked for two years in the Kuwait Ministry of Health providing dental care for elementary school children and found her passion for being pediatric dentist. This led Dr. Ritwik to pursue a residency in Pediatric Dentistry from Louisiana State University School of Dentistry and a Masters of Science in Oral Biology. A strong sense of advocacy for high standards in pediatric oral health led her to become a consultant for the ABPD and a member of its Examination Committee. She served as the Advanced Education Program Director in Pediatric Dentistry and as Director of the Special Children's Dental Clinic, Children's Hospital New Orleans, Louisiana. Dr. Ritwik is a consultant to the Commission on Dental Accreditation, highlighting her commitment to excellence in oral health education. Dr. Ritwik has worked with the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry for developing guidelines for clinical care through her role as a consultant to the Council on Clinical Affairs. She has published in numerous national and international journals and textbooks, including evidence-based guidelines for the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.

Dr. Ritwik regularly provides lectures and continuing education courses on pediatric oral health topics for various national and international groups. She balances her academic career in pediatric dentistry by teaching doctoral and post-doctoral students, maintaining private clinical practice, conducting research and promoting interprofessional collaborative practice for advancing pediatric oral health.

Management of Dental Trauma

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Dental trauma encompasses a broad spectrum of injuries, from minor fractures to more severe cases affecting the pulp and periodontal tissues. Avulsion of a permanent tooth is a time-sensitive injury. In these urgent situations, the entire dental team—including dentists, dental assistants and dental hygienists—plays a vital role in patient care. Prompt and well-informed decisions are essential to ensure the best long-term functional and esthetic outcomes. Dr. Ritwik will present a case-based discussion on the biological principles and clinical techniques for managing common dental injuries. By following contemporary dental trauma guidelines and evidence-based treatment recommendations, participants will gain the knowledge and confidence to effectively manage traumatic dental injuries in young patients, leading to more predictable outcomes.

- Diagnose and classify dental injuries.
 - Evaluate effective and efficient treatment options for the most common dental injuries in primary and permanent teeth.
 - Determine prognosis and anticipate complications stemming from traumatic dental injuries.



Contemporary Restorative Options: Minimally Invasive Techniques to Crowns for Primary Teeth

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The traditional approach to managing loss of tooth structure from dental caries in pediatric patients has been restorative techniques, such as fillings and stainless-steel crowns. There is however an expanding range of options for nonsurgical medical management and minimally invasive techniques to facilitate compassionate dental care for pediatric patients. Dental hygienists, dental assistants and dentists play a key role in assessing caries risk and guiding treatment choices that best support each child's oral health. In this section of the course, Dr Ritwik will discuss the role of guided enamel remineralization, resin infiltration, silver diamine fluoride and Hall crowns for pediatric patients. She will also review clinical techniques for the use of stainless-steel crowns, composite strip crowns, pre-veneered esthetic crowns, zirconia crowns, and medical-grade resin crowns. These contemporary techniques will be supported by evaluating the child's caries risk, medical status, and parental preferences to ensure a personalized approach to care.
